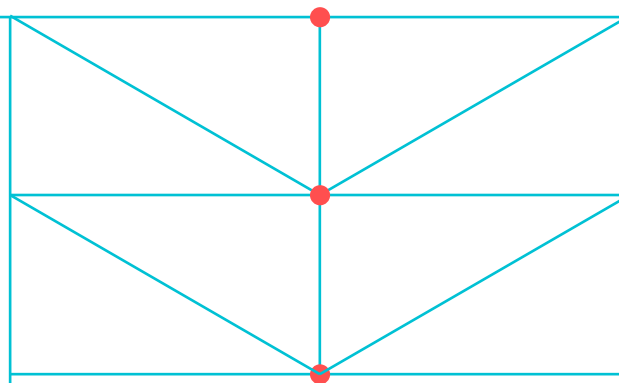
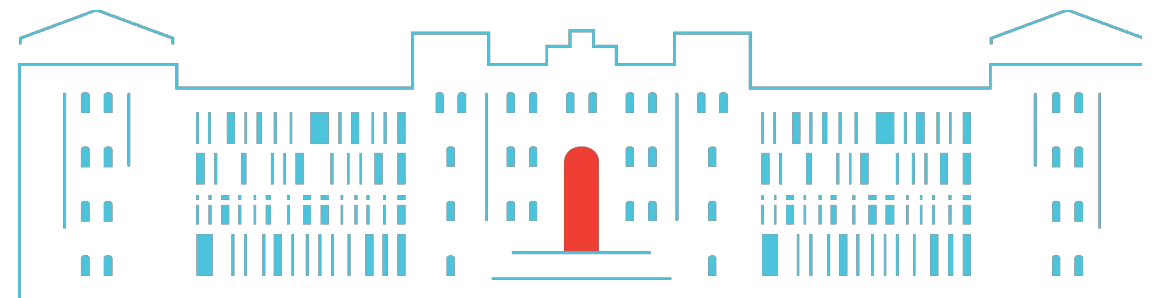

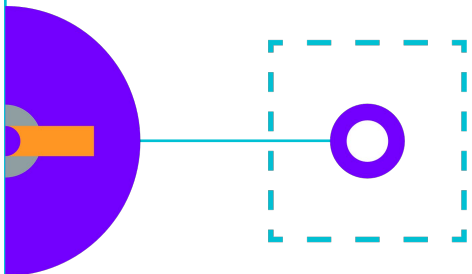

Co-Moderation of this Roundtable

- 4Science is a company located in Italy
- Developers of DSpace-CRIS
- DSpace-CRIS is an extension to DSpace, which introduced CRIS capabilities (like entities) to generic DSpace
- DSpace-CRIS contains a full ORCID integration for some years
- Most of the integration components have been ported to DSpace 7.3 by 4Science

ORCID Integration in DSpace (>= 7.3)

- ORCID integration is NOT enabled by default
- Other optional features must be enabled to use the ORCID integration
 - Configurable Entities: Person, Publication, Project & OrgUnit
 - Researcher Profile
- ORCID Member API are required to get the most from this integration (push)
- It is not required to enable the ORCID login to use the ORCID Integration

ORCID Global Participation Fund (GPF)

TUHH

- TUHH has been awarded by the GPF of an implementation project by 4Science to improve the ORCID Login process
 - Allowing users that doesn't release their email address via ORCID to login
 - Avoiding duplication of account if the ORCID email \neq DSpace account email
- Target for DSpace-CRIS with the aims to be ported to DSpace as well
- Expected by the end of 2023

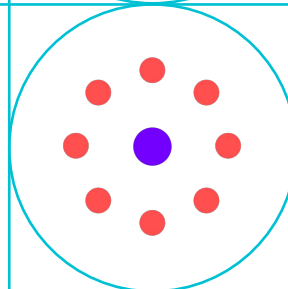
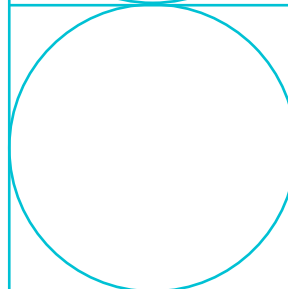
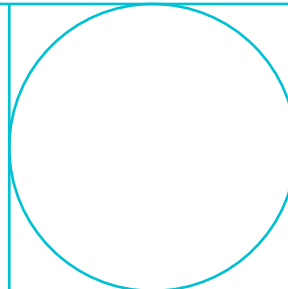
