

PCC SCS Recommended Extensions to Related Place of RDA Entity

Introduction

RDA has a general element named Related Place of RDA Entity for a place that is associated with an RDA entity. Many narrower elements are available in RDA such as Related Place of Person, Related Place of Work, and for many of these, there are even further narrower elements, such as Place of Birth, Place of Death, Place of Conference, Place of Origin of Work, etc. When a narrower element is not available in RDA, a broader element may be used to record a related place. An example would be recording the burial place of a person using the element Related Place of Person.

In MARC 21 authority and bibliographic records, related place may be recorded in field 370. Some subfields are defined narrowly, such as subfield \$a for Place of Birth and subfield \$g for Place of Origin of Work or Expression. When a narrow subfield is not defined, catalogers may use subfield \$f, defined in MARC as “Other associated place.” Many types of place relationships may be encoded in 370 \$f, but the exact nature of the relationship cannot be determined solely by the subfield. For that, MARC provides for relationship information in subfields \$i (“Relationship information”) and \$4 (“Relationship”). The same issue may also occur with subfield \$c (“Associated country”), where a more specific label for a relationship to a country is desirable, such as “Country of citizenship,” and “Country of production.”

MARC 370 subfield \$i can be used to record an uncontrolled textual phrase or a controlled textual value from a list of relationships. In authority records, current PCC policy is to use only approved relationship designators appearing in the RDA Toolkit¹. PCC does permit the use of relationship designators from other vocabularies in bibliographic records², although the guidelines do not specifically say anything about 3XX fields. RDA relationship designators are currently taken from Appendices I, J, K and M from the original RDA Toolkit. Once PCC implements the new RDA, relationship values will be taken from [Metadata Guidance Documentation: Relationship Labels](#). These labels are based on RDA relationship elements, but PCC will use “deverbalized unconstrained elements” based on the [unconstrained verbalized elements in the RDA Registry](#).

MARC 370 subfield \$4 can be used to record a code or URI that specifies the relationship from the entity described in the record to the entity referenced in the field. PCC policy is to use URIs only, usually unconstrained URIs from the RDA Registry. There are URIs for properties in Wikidata or other linked data applications that could be used when the RDA Registry lacks one.

Because catalogers often use MARC 370 subfield \$f to record related places that do not have specific RDA relationship elements defined, the PCC Standing Committee on Standards considered the kinds of place relationships that have been or potentially could be recorded in subfield \$f and has agreed to create a list of additional relationship labels that can be used in NACO, BIBCO, and CONSER records. These terms will be incorporated into [Metadata Guidance Documentation: Relationship Labels](#). This list represents a community extension of narrower related place elements under the RDA element Related Place of RDA Entity. Because PCC policy is to use unconstrained elements, some terms in this list may be

used for more than one RDA entity. For example, while “Burial Place” would only be applicable to persons, “Place of Activity” and “Research Site” would be applicable to any kind of agent. Additionally, some terms in this list are not constrained to taking a place as their value, and could also be used in MARC 373 subfield \$i to record a relationship to a corporate body.³ An example is “Burial Place,” which could have a value of a geographic place or a cemetery. Another example is “Location of First Performance,” which could be used with places as well as entities tagged as corporate bodies.

Relationships to places may also be recorded in field 551. However, only places established in the LC/NACO Authority File may be used in the 551 field. The terms on this list may also be used in subfield \$i of the field.
