#### 2013-2014: Fedora 4 Learning Curve

- Followed F4 alpha and beta development
- Experimented with JCR and Modeshape features
- Understood Fedora long-term goals better




### **2015: Getting Down To Business**

- Capitalized on previous learning experience
- Defined milestones; more conservative feature set
- Adopted as many community standards as possible
- Proposed non-core features

# **DAMS Phase 1: Hydra Component**

- Gateway for all client access
- Content modeling
- Security framework
- Manager front end
- Custom REST API



## **DAMS Phase 1: Camel Integration**

- Indexing
- Content filtering and deployment (public mirror)
- Automation (sequencer migration)



### **DAMS Phase 1: External Systems**

- Federation performance still not production quality
- Alternatively use Camel to CRUD external records
- Integrate legacy CMS on a separate timeline



# **AIC DAMS Phase 2 (2015-2016)**

- Adopt PCDM and WebACL when stabilized
- Support more media types, complex models
- Publishing contexts
- More automation tasks (Camel)
- Triplestore index with RDFS/OWL inference
