









## Adoption of platforms over time



DSpace steady growth- 250 new DSpace instances in 2014 Now have 1,828 DSpace and 332 Fedora





Continued adoption around the world, particularly developing countries in the Middle East & Asia


# 2014 Membership by Geography DSpace/Fedora/VIVO/General



33% from outside USA International Members increased by 5%




# Diversified Funding Streams \$1.9 million 2014

(Includes Community Membership, Corporate Sponsorship, Registered Service Providers)








# Community Fundraising Growth
