Definition: Visual citation : an artistic process/practice where a creator reproduces the totality or a section of a (well-known) work of art to incorporate it a new visual creation.

Future work:

- 1) The need for a property “variantOf” was identified for cases where it is known that one work is a variant of another, but not which one came first. Instead of minting a local property, we will use `bf:relatedTo` for the time being. Once the moratorium on proposing new relationship designators in RDA is lifted, we will propose “variantOf” for fine arts based on the relationship available for music.
- 2) VRA RDF contains a number of relationships that are potentially useful, however, VRA RDF does not contain definitions. These relationships are also only listed without definitions in VRA Core and CCO. We will investigate the usage of these relationships further, AAT could serve as a definition source for some of the terms.
- 3) `artframe:cites` and `artframe:CitedBy` closely related to `cidoc:P65`, not identical. Add `skos:closeMatch` to our property
