5. Data enhancement

5.1 Adding new data

Where additional data useful to identify a person/organisation or to disambiguate identities has been found during the course of research, this can be added to the appropriate record on ISNI.

Example

A full name **Ho, Wing Sze Vanessa** has been found for the identity **Ho, W. S** by the ISNI Quality Team.

The name can be added to the record, along with the source and any relevant citations to justify the information found. To edit the record select the **UPDATE** function above the search bar.

The record will display as follows:

5.1.1 Justifying new data – adding public/non-public notes

Where data has been added to the record, it must be justified with relevant citations.

In the following example two **external information found notes** have been added to the record to justify the additional forms of name found.

5.1.2 006 verification field

An 006 verification field is added manually to all records where data enhancement and/or correction has taken place.³

All data enhancement is classed as **data corrected** for the purposes of the verification field.

5.1.3 Adding data source

Where new data is added to the record there will need to be a corresponding main name heading added for the same source.⁴

Example

In the following record the title "Alaskan summer" has been added by the ISNI Quality Team following an enduser request.

The error message states that the source code ISNI is contained in the 910, 921 and 943 MARC21 fields but is not found in any main heading (700/710).

To correct the error, a main heading will need to be added to match the source of the new data.

5.2 Public and non-public note fields

Where new data has been added to an existing record, it is best practice to justify with appropriate citations.

There are 4 potential note fields on ISNI⁵:

- **667 – General non-public note, only displaying in member and administrative view**
- **668 – General public note**
- **670 – External information found (e.g. websites, bibliographic reference works, etc.) – non-public note, only displaying in member and administrative view**
- **671 – External information found (e.g. websites, bibliographic reference works, etc.) – public note**

5.2.1 667 non-public note

Non-public notes can be added by ISNI members and the Quality Team to explain editing actions. They are also generated via user queries on the ISNI public database.

5.2.2 668 public note

5.2.3 670 external information found - non-public note

670 non-public notes are usually generated via enduser queries on the ISNI public database¹².

Endusers may include web links with their queries to provide additional information.

5.3 Adding other identifiers

Additional identifiers may be added to an ISNI record. These identifiers include:

- **ORCID** (Open Researcher and Contributor ID) - a subset of ISNI uniquely identifying scientific and other academic authors with a 16-digit identifier (<http://orcid.org/>)
- **ResearcherID** - assigns unique identifiers to researchers (www.researcherid.com)
- **Scopus** - a bibliographic database containing abstracts and citations for academic journal articles (<http://www.elsevier.com/online-tools/scopus>)

Identifiers are added using the **other identifier field** on ISNI – **090 MARC21, 006Z PICA**.

- **Weblinks for all other identifiers apart from ORCID require a public external information found note, as well as adding to the other identifier field. An automatic link is only created to ORCID and not to other identifiers – 5.3.2.2**

5.4 Deleting ISNI records

There are normally 2 scenarios where an ISNI record would be deleted:

- Endusers can request the cancellation/deletion of their ISNI. We would delete the data in accordance with the ISNI data policy - **Upon request from the data subject, ISNI will delete the personal data, without undue delay, and notify each data subject of its deletion, unless this proves impossible or involves a disproportionate effort.**²⁰
- Two or more records **from the same data source** exist **with the same identifier**²¹

Example

There are two **SCHU** records for the identity **Flatau, Paul** with the same identifier in the 035 field – **ISNI: 0000 0003 7228 7672** and **0000 0003 7228 7702**.



Retain the record with richer data. If the records are identical, select the record with the lowest ISNI for deletion.

In this example, the data in both records is identical so the lowest ISNI will be retained – **0000 0003 7228 7672**.

To delete the record select **DELETE** above the search bar (note that there is no need to select **UPDATE** first).

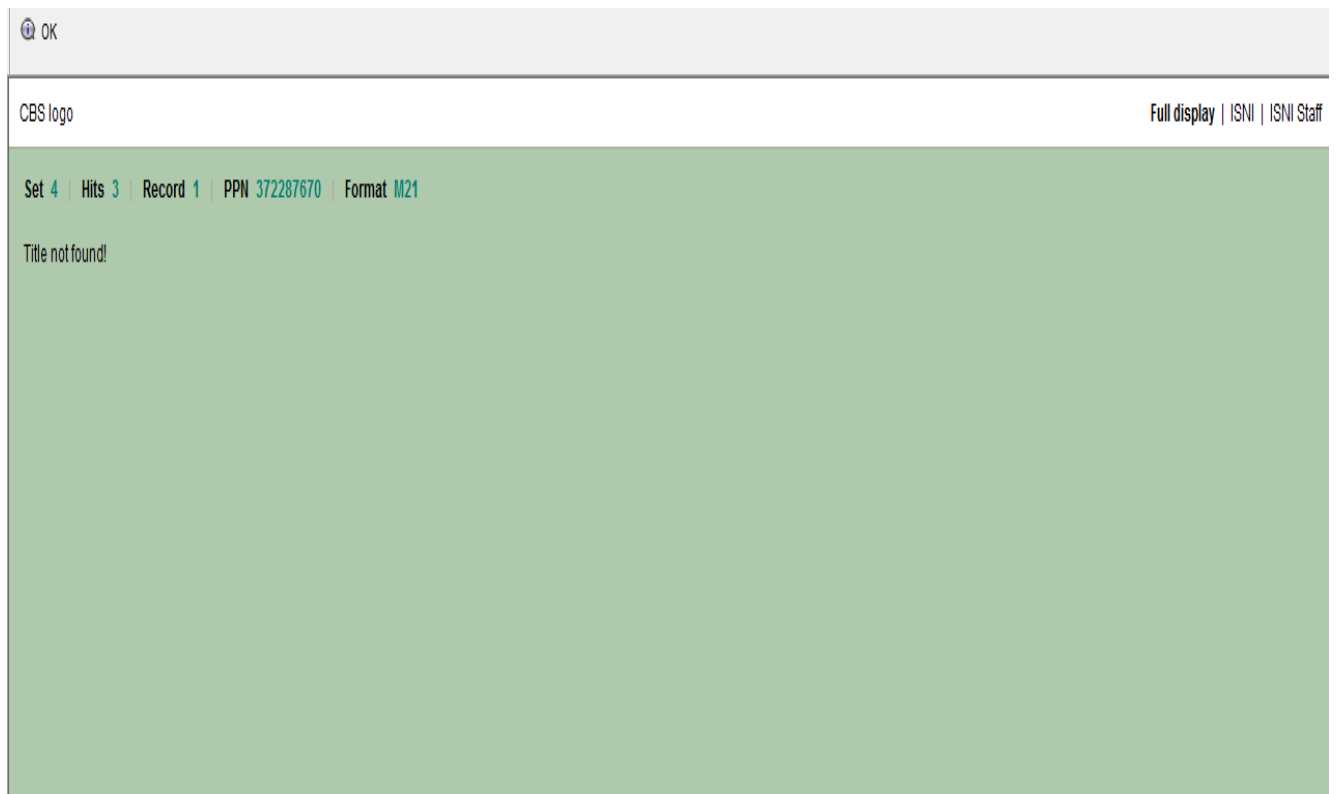


The record will appear on a new screen with a ***final option*** to delete. Select **DELETE** again.

Note that the deletion will only occur if this second delete option is selected.



Once the deletion is complete the following display will appear:



To exit this display, select the back blue arrow key on the toolbar to return to any previous search results (see **2.9.4**) or begin a new search using the search bar (see **2.2**) or the search form (see **2.4.1**).

An 097 field will need to be added to the retained record with the deprecated ISNI of the deleted record²².

The source will also need to be notified of the duplication. For notifying VIAF data sources, see **8.3.3**. For non-VIAF source notifications using the 977 field, see **8.2.1.2**.

The field contains the following data:

- *\$t subfield*: **dataError** – a report of the problem
- *\$2 subfield*: **SCHU** – the data source requiring notification
- *\$b subfield*: **2012-10-11 17:00:06** - the date and time the notification was added to the record
- *\$z subfield*: **Two Scholar Universe records with the identifier SCHU\$0F0BCD82FCE47B01D00DA4430AC20F716** - the note to the source highlighting the nature of the problem

Note that when deleting assigned records following a user request, there will be no retained record. All data would be removed from ISNI in accordance with the data policy. Any data sources on the record would need to be notified. For notifying VIAF data sources, see 8.3.3. For non-VIAF source notifications, OCLC should be contacted.

5.5 Suppressing ISNI data

Endusers can request the suppression of their personal data on ISNI, e.g. dates of birth or an unused forename.

In these cases the personal data should be deleted from the ISNI record, as requested by the enduser²³. A non-public note should be added to the record to explain the editing work carried out and clarify which data has been removed²⁴.

Example

An enduser has requested their date of birth be removed from the ISNI database. The date was removed by the ISNI Quality Team from the 700 and 970 field.

A non-public note has been added by the ISNI Quality Team to highlight the removal of the date of birth and clarify why this work had been carried out.

5.5.1 Adding the Protect field

Where data has been removed or changed, it is advisable to manually add a protect field to prevent the corrected record from being overwritten by future updates²⁵.

A date of birth has been removed from the record below, following a user request. An 009 protect field has been added to prevent the date of birth returning to the record in future updates.

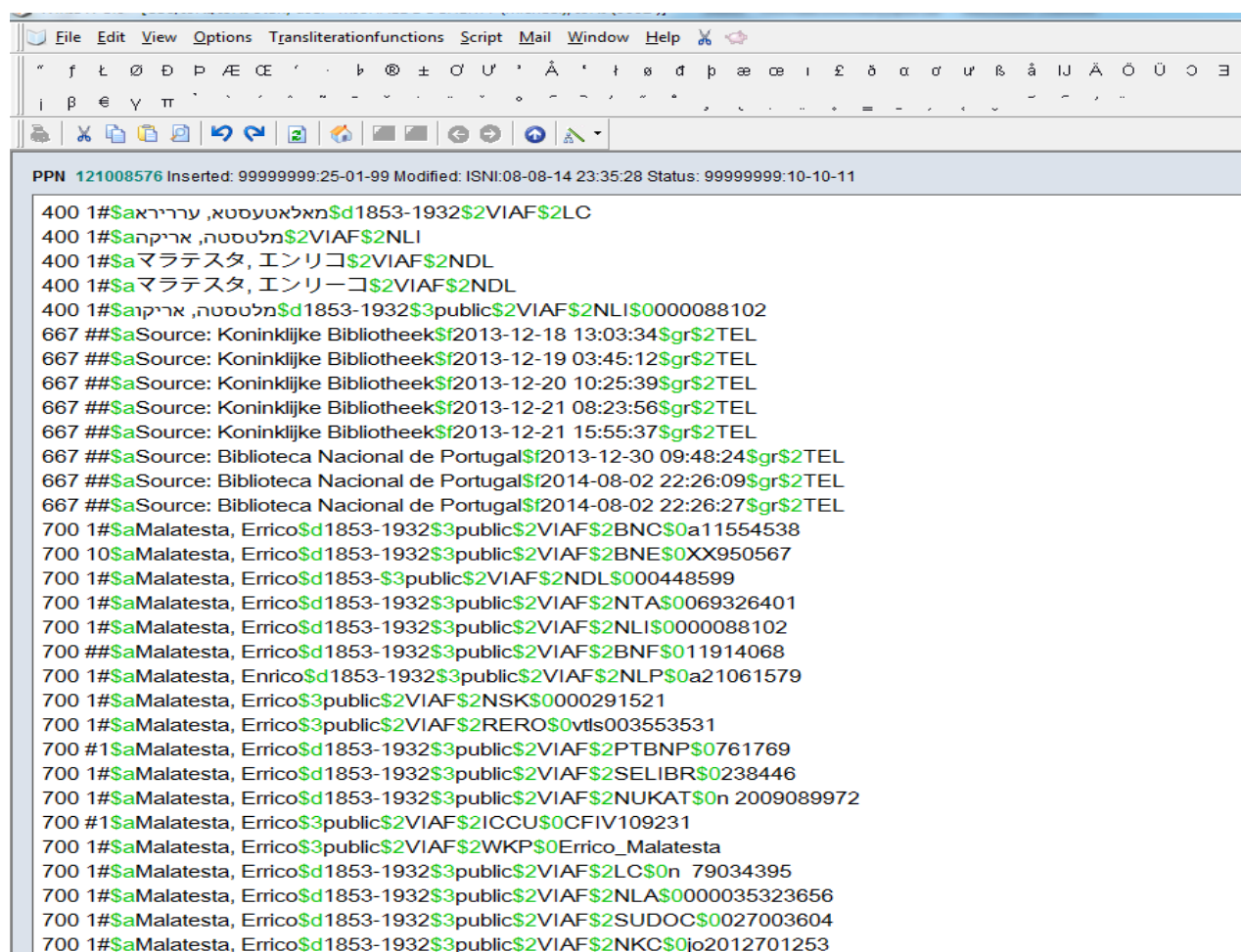
5.6 Diacritics

Diacritics can be manually added to ISNI data.

Example

The title **Au café, dialogues sur le socialisme anarchique** needs to be added to the record for the identity **Enrico Malatesta**.

Select **UPDATE**, followed by **CTRL+D**. A list of diacritics appears at the top of the editing screen.



The diacritic can be added using the list at the top of the screen.

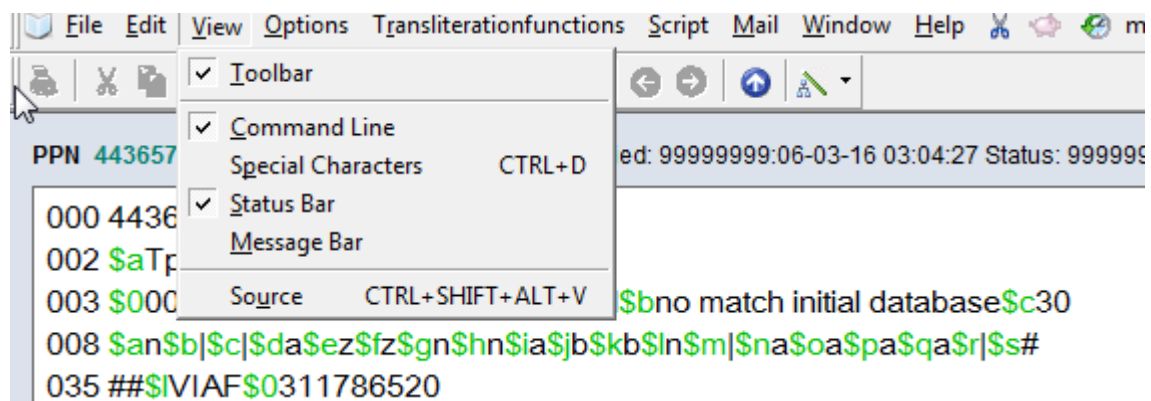
To use the list place the cursor after the letter requiring the diacritic. Select the appropriate diacritic from the list and single-click with the mouse. The diacritic will then be inserted in the correct position.

To remove the list of diacritics from the top of the screen select **CTRL+D** again.

Alternatively, to view diacritics select **VIEW** and **SPECIAL CHARACTERS** from the list.

Example



Selecting **SPECIAL CHARACTERS** will display the list of diacritics at the top of the screen. Follow the same procedure as above to insert diacritics into the record.

To remove the list of diacritics go to **VIEW** and de-select **SPECIAL CHARACTERS** from the list.

5.7 Suspect records

Records with a **suspect** ISNI status are not displayed on the public database. These records were formerly assigned but an error was identified and the status changed to suspect.

Where a **suspect** record is found, the status can be manually changed back to assigned if there are no errors or once any appropriate editing work has been carried out.

A programme was run on the ISNI database in 2012 to highlight potential anomalies in regard to dates. The ISNI status was changed on records containing anomalies from assigned to suspect.

Select **ENTER**. The ISNI status has now changed to assigned and the record is viewable on the public database.

5.8 Upgrading provisional status records to assigned

Provisional status records can be manually upgraded on WinIBW to assigned³⁰.

Example

The identity David Earl Hart has a provisional status ISNI – **0000 0000 4768 0016**
