<b>Email groups</b> <a href="#">ld4pcohort Google group</a> (mailing list for cohort project leads, administrators, anyone at cohort institutions who needs to be informed about administrative topics like cohort in-person meetings, subgrant administration, etc.)	contact <a href="#">Michelle Futornick</a> to request to join (owners and managers of ld4pcohort Google group can add new members)
<b>PCCTG1 listserv</b> (mailing list maintained by PCC specifically for catalogers working in Sinopia, where catalogers can share tips, post questions, and offer answers.	Send email to <a href="mailto:PCCTG1-request@LISTSERV.LOC.GOV">PCCTG1-request@LISTSERV.LOC.GOV</a> and include the words "Subscribe PCCTG1" in the subject line. Or visit the listserv page on LC's listserv site <a href="https://listserv.loc.gov/cgi-bin/wa?A0=PCCTG1">https://listserv.loc.gov/cgi-bin/wa?A0=PCCTG1</a> (You will need to create an account there if you don't have one if you want to subscribe via the listserv site, view the list archives, or manage your preferences.)
<b>Directory / Roster</b> <a href="#">Roster</a> (card view of a Google sheets doc; formerly a SmartSheet online spreadsheet; we no longer have a SmartSheet license)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• go to the <a href="#">sheet with the data</a> and add a new row (you need to be a member of the ld4pcohort Google group to do this, see above)</li> <li>• to add a photo, upload to the <a href="#">Roster-Sheet Images Google drive folder</a> and back on the sheet, in the Photo column, add a link, following the format of the existing links (you need to be a member of the ld4pcohort Google group to do this, see above) or</li> <li>• contact <a href="#">Michelle Futornick</a> to be added</li> </ul>
<b>Slack public workspace</b> join public LD4 Slack workspace (address of the workspace is ld4.slack.com, but use the invite link <a href="http://bit.ly/ld4slack">http://bit.ly/ld4slack</a> to join)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• anyone can join by themselves using this invite link <a href="http://bit.ly/ld4slack">http://bit.ly/ld4slack</a> or</li> <li>• ask someone who's already a member of the slack workspace to invite you (they can follow <a href="#">How to invite new people to a workspace</a>)</li> <li>• you cannot sign up directly at ld4.slack.com, you need the above bit.ly invite link, or an invite link sent to you by a current member</li> </ul>
