

Installation

In this section, you will find installation instructions for Islandora, aimed at different use cases:

ISLE: Islandora Enterprise

ISLE is a community developed and supported set of resources for quickly building and updating a fully functioning Islandora platform using a system building tool called [Docker](#). The ISLE documentation provides clear instructions on how to do the following types of installations and updates:

- [New ISLE](#): create a new ISLE instance on a production, staging or development server
- [Update ISLE](#): update a preexisting ISLE instance with improvements and security updates
- [Migrate to ISLE](#): migrate a non-ISLE Islandora 7x instance to ISLE on a production, staging or development server
- [Test/Demo ISLE](#): create a new ISLE instance on my laptop or workstation

Traditional Islandora Installation Methods

- [Manual Server Installation \(Copy\)](#): suitable for full installations of Islandora in a development or production environment. Aimed at users with some technical experience.
- [Manual Migration/Upgrade](#): suitable for existing Islandora installations, covering the migration or upgrade of each major component of an Islandora site: Drupal, Islandora Modules, and Fedora.
- [Virtual Machine](#) (Test/Demo): suitable for new users who want explore or experiment with Islandora, requiring minimal time and set-up. Aimed at a general audience.
