- 6. import-export best to not rely on specific version semantics so that in future it could be possible to use the same (similar) code to import/export from various versions of Fedora.
 - a. How do we determine whether an external, maybe the status code and store the information. Perhaps store a constructed Link header that would be usable to recreate the resource and would store the redirect/proxy definition.
