1. Updates and announcements
 - a. UMD has a number of local projects, unable to contribute to Fedora 6 sprints in the short-term
 - i. Moving a number of local VMs into Kubernetes
 - b. NLM making a similar push
 - i. Migrating outdated CentOS systems
 - ii. Not enough support yet to push everything to AWS before EOL
 - iii. Also looking at Kubernetes
 - c. NLM Fedora migration testing
 - i. Encountered some errors but these have since been resolved
 - ii. Still need to introduce NLM specifics to the new Fedora 6 environment
 1. Define target end state
 - iii. Also working on some load testing
2. Fedora 6.x Testing
 - a. Andrew tested creating ~15 million empty containers with no major issues
 - i. Tests have been against Postgres so far, still need to test other DBs
 - b. Also tested S3 but much slower
3. Alpha/Beta release
 - a. Planning on a release in November
 - b. Alpha or beta?
 - i. Alpha might not get tested, folks might wait until beta
 - ii. What is the target audience?
 1. Ready for testing outside the tech team
 - iii. Alpha/beta distinction is not as important as the context we provide with the release
 - c. What do we need to encourage testing?
 - i. Docker would be ideal for testing
