

# System Requirements

- Java 11

- Servlet 3.0 container such as:
  - [Tomcat 9](#)
  - [Jetty 9.x](#)
- A case-sensitive filesystem. Fedora 6 stores resources on disk in an [OCFL repository](#), and OCFL [requires a case-sensitive filesystem](#). By default, Windows and Mac systems use case-insensitive filesystems. If you intend to run Fedora on such a system, you have to make sure to meet 1 of the following requirements:
  - Locate Fedora home on a case-sensitive volume. This is an exercise for the reader.
  - Do not use Archival Groups. Case related resource name collisions can only happen when dealing with resources contained within the same Archival Group.
  - Do not name two different resources the same but with different casing.
