 - solution: cut the release for now and continue to refine post-release, figure out if total search result should be on single page or multiple page
 - other PR's are generally improvements
- Danny Bernstein noticed a slowness in item creation in MySql at around 60k items jmeter test results
- · camel toolbox work is in currently in process
- UVA had an issue with running fedora with HTTPS apache proxy server, specifically with X-Forwarded-Proto (XFP) header when RDF rendered http even through content served is https
