

Add logos to an items display (Manakin)

Files:

Instructions:

1. If you haven't already, you need to [Create+a+new+theme](#)
2. Locate the template named "itemSummaryList-DIM" inside the base DIM (DSpace Intermediate Metadata) handler. This is the template that is used to display an individual item with in a larger list, as on the browse by page and search results. <p>

3. Copy the template identified above into your theme's local template.xml stylesheet. This will allow the theme to override the default behavior.
4. Modify the template to add an

element for the logo. The image used will be based upon a Dublin Core field, in the example below dc.type is used.
