New and Changed Features

Islandora 6.x-13.1.x is a release that represents many small changes and back-end improvements rather than a major change in the functionality that users have become accustomed to. The underlying code is more stable and streamlined and a large number of bugs, both major and minor, have been addressed (see Bug Fixes below). Four new modules are included as part of this release, adding new tools and functionality to Islandora:

Autocomplete Module

The Islandora Autocomplete module allows users to define auto-complete URL's to be used in a Drupal form in conjunction with the #autocomplete property of form elements. By using the Islandora Autocomplete module, users with appropriate permissions can define and upload .csv files that will fill one or more fields of a given Islandora form when a user begins typing. XACML Editor

The XACML Editor module allows users with sufficient permissions to configure XACML policy on a per-collection or per-object basis through a graphical user interface instead of by writing the policies in XML. The File Information Tool Set (FITS) identifies, validates, and extracts technical metadata for various file formats. It wraps several third-party open source tools, normalizes and consolidates their output, and reports any errors.
