 - o will replace, assign, merge metadata
 - Mark Wood and Richard agree that we need some validation capability, but not in this tool
 - doesn't completely solve migration issues mapping for tool needs to be defined in config, not available curation
 - Sarah P.: can we test out tool before it is included in DSpace will post comment on proposal page ask if tool will be in 4.0 and that DCAT is ready to help test - either now or during testathon
- · Project chunks
 - o good idea to break up, get more people involved
 - o first 2 to start with
 - validate preliminary DC mapping
 - validate the phases/stagings are all phases necessary/make sense: Proposal to Update DC Registry and Add DCTERMS Registry
- Review group
 - Sarah P.: was on NISO review group great way to get feedback
 - Sarah M.: can get people to participate for a short time because it is targeted and limited, locally refer to it as a "task & finish group"
 - Val: perhaps review group/task & finish group could be used to validate the DC mapping, may allow for broader participation and for DC compliance experts outside DSpace community to participate because it is a defined/short period
 - Bram: difference between terms "mapping" vs. "crosswalk" from DSpace developers perspective crosswalk usually references OAI-PMH – we should use the term "mapping"
 - metadata team has done the preliminary DC mapping, needs to be reviewed and validated to confirm the end result compliant: h ttps://docs.google.com/a/fedora-commons.org/spreadsheet/ccc?key=0AgUhtsSmo31dEtaM1M1Q2E1NIRxNG11ZHFrSkMxNFE#gid=0
 - Sarah P.: is going to the DC conference in 2 weeks, will try to find some resources for a review group on mapping
 - Elin: Jessica Lindholm from Univ of Malmo? in Sweden is a metadata expert
 - Sarah P: metadata team needs to clean up the mapping a bit before review group
 - Sarah: also believe that we need a review group to validate the staging/phases
 - challenging to unpack all issues technical infrastructure issues, dc compliance issues, etc.
 - need dc experts to validate as well as dspace metadata experts, also broader community of what is supportable
 - o Actions:

 - add link to OR13 preso on proposal page
 - clean up the preliminary DC mapping
