i. Are we able to emit events when a transaction ends?
2. If we treat transactions as resources, we can emit messages on transaction begin and transaction completion, be it a 'Commit' or 'Rollback' event. Easy to support as long as we tie it to the transaction as a resource. Need to present transactions/operations as a first class resource.
3. It may be recommended to use the User Agent mechanism to tag transaction events. This would allow tracking of independent transactions and identify which messages result from which transactions.

5. Question around deployable artifacts in related libraries
a. fcrepo-camel-webapp 4.4.0 deprecated war file usage in favour of OSGi deploy via Karaf
b. We should document that automated work should rely on Maven as the canonical source of artifacts to avoid the issue of needing to place copies in many places.
